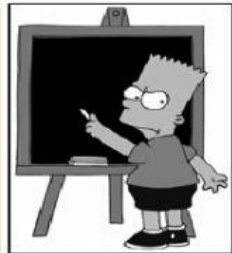


# FIRST CONDITIONAL

We use the First Conditional to refer to actions that are likely to happen in the future.

IF	SUBJECT	PRESENT SIMPLE	SUBJECT	FUTURE SIMPLE
If	many people	drive cars,	pollution	will increase.
IF	CONDITION		RESULT OR CONSEQUENCE	



UNLESS = IF NOT

If you don't work harder, you will fail your exam  
Unless you work harder, you will fail your exam
